Short description of his career and the interest in police work:

On graduating in 1982 he joined the Malmo police department. He started his career as a down town patrol officer. In 1992 he transferred to the CIB on promotion to the rank of inspector. He subsequently specialized in the fight against drugs (narcotic). During the year of 1992 – 1995 he started various projects on problem-oriented work fore preventing and detecting drug crime and drug related crimes. He was 1995 awarded the National Police Commissioner’s prize for distinguished service in the national fight against drugs.

In 1997 he attended the Senior Comand Course at the National Police College in Stockholm. In 1997 he transferred to the Police Division, Swedish National Police Board (SNPB). He served as co-manager fore the national crime prevention program and he is specialised in the field of ‘Community Oriented Policing.

In the year 2001 Police Superintendent Tom Jensen became the first chief of the new established local police district for the town Landskrona (40.000 inhabitant). The city is located in the very south of Sweden.

Short description of his activities and/or publications:

Since his year at the Swedish National Police Board (1997 – 1999) Mr Tom Jensen has collaborated with over 20 police agencies around EU and in the USA in the field of Community Oriented Policing. He is the author of the book “Initiatives taken by the Swedish police with a view to Preventing, detecting and curbing drug abuse in the young population” (Swedish National Police College). He is also author of many articles of problem oriented and community oriented work methods for the police, public prosecution authorities and social services. He is continuity give lectures and seminars at the National Police College.
