Short description of her/his career and the interest in police work:

Assistant and researcher within the Centre de recherches criminologiques of the Université libre de Bruxelles, after having worked within the formation and research center Synergie where he has been in charge of the evaluation of projects developed within the framework of the Belgian policy of the Contracts of security. The interest carried to the questions of police force developed starting from work relating to the police of proximity and the development of Community Policing in Belgium. This interest was prolonged by more varied work, but is centred mainly on the development of knowledge by and on the police, the contemporary evolution of the police institution, its bodies, its practices, and in a general way the very design of the police function. It is within this framework that many contacts were developed with police actors or administrations, formation institutions and authorities concerned by police work, in particular through the creation of the Centre d'études sur la police whose presidency he currently assumes.

Short description of her/his activities and/or publications:

His researches and publications related mainly to the policies regarding public safety as well as the police in various dimensions, as well strictly national as of comparison with other countries. They thus related to police practices, in particular local ones, or to the installation and evaluation of contractualized policies of public safety and prevention, to reforms regarding police forces, as well as to the development of knowledge on these matters.

Confirming this interest for this police knowledge, as well as scientific, within the framework of the Centre d'études sur la police study days are regularly organized on

varied topics concerning the exercise of police function, stimulating the exchanges and reflections of actors coming from various institutional backgrounds.

Educational background:

He graduated in philosophy and criminology. He is currently finishing a Ph.D. in criminology on the topic of the recent evolutions of police management conceptions in Belgium.
